

## Turkish Perps

Characteristics: Istanbul is a big city. Thus many perps can bring their friends to where TI is staying to build a secure surveillance team. Also, the local perps might be able to speak the native languages of the TI due to the multi cultural society. In the big cities, the TIs may encounter many perps from their native countries. Also, there are perps from Australia, Germany, Russia, and other countries just traveling as backpackers and tourists. The difference is that these perps know many people already in the area, so they can invite more people. The perps showing up in the public buildings might be able to communicate with the manager class employees. You can find such 'official surveillance' but armature looking from the TIs view in post offices and train stations. The taxi drivers and tour guides are often working for the gang stalking. The taxi drivers might drop the TI off in the area which is not where the TI wants to go. Also, some taxi drivers might drop the TI at the place he or she wanted to go and said to someone else or one's plan which is secretly viewed by the perps. In the train, the passengers near the TI would communicate often with the conductor in the train.

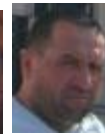

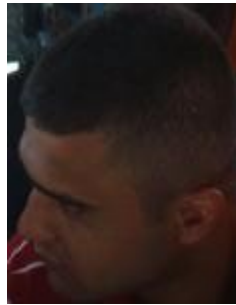
A typical perps with CA logo.

This guy sat in St. Anthony church with Samurai logo T-shirt.

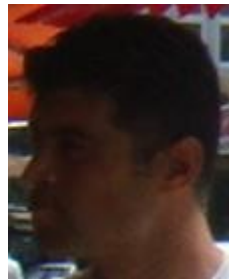
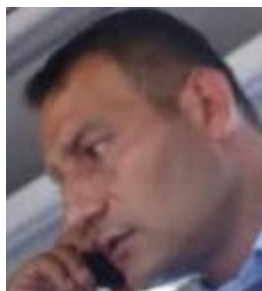

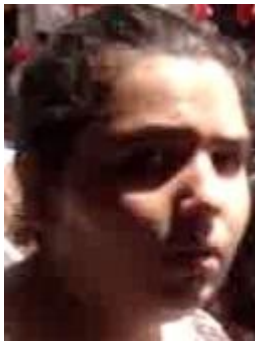

These Muslim looking women went into St. Anthony church with their head covering on. I saw many women like these entering the church when I visited there.

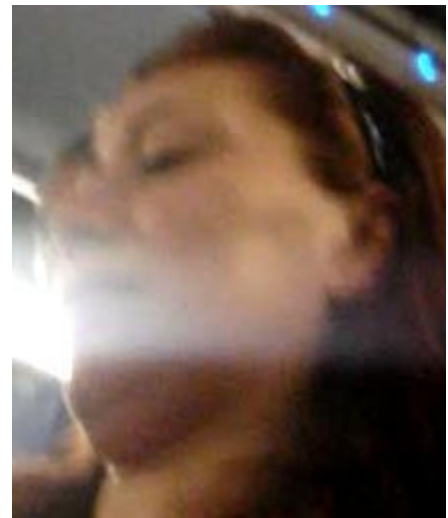
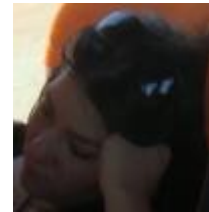
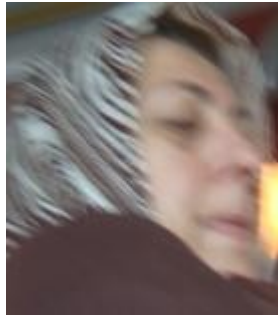
From Izmir:
